Given the expressed concern of many students and parents regarding SAT performance, one evening and one afternoon SAT Preparation course will be offered at Manasquan High School this year, in conjunction with the Manasquan PTO. The course will be taught by Mr. Paul Battaglia of the Manasquan High School Mathematics Department and Mrs. Monica Fenlon of the Manasquan High School English Department. The course will be limited to the first 50 students to register, with class sizes set at a maximum of 25. However, if enrollment is low, classes will be combined and meet on Wednesday evening. The cost for the course is \$250.00 payable to the Manasquan High School PTO upon registration. Registration will be held at Manasquan High School, Room 109, on Tuesday September 20th from 2:30 to 3:15 p.m. on a first come, first serve basis.
