Cabrini College has scholarships for qualified students.

## Academic Scholarships and Grants

Cabrini College offers academic merit awards to eligible incoming freshmen based on high school grade point average (GPA) and SAT and/or ACT scores. All applicants to the College are considered.

Students must be registered as full-time (12 or more credits per semester) and maintain satisfactory academic success each year to continue to be eligible.

Cabrini offers the following academic merit awards for the Fall 2012 incoming class with a minimum criteria listed below:

>> **PRESIDENT'S SCHOLARSHIP** – a minimum 1100 SAT (critical reading and math) or higher, or 24 ACT composite score or higher, with a minimum 3.5 GPA in academic courses.

>> **PROVOST'S SCHOLARSHIP** – a minimum 1100 SAT (critical reading and math) or higher, or 24 ACT composite score or higher, with a minimum 3.0 GPA in academic courses. Candidates with a 4.0 GPA and less than 1100 SAT (24 ACT) also may be considered.

>> **DEAN'S SCHOLARSHIP** – a minimum 900 SAT (critical reading and math) or higher, or 19 ACT composite score or higher, with a 3.0-4.0 GPA in academic courses.

>> **FOUNDER'S GRANT** – Available for full-time freshmen applicants who have been accepted to Cabrini College and have not been considered for other academic scholarships.

## Other Institutional Scholarships and Grants

Cabrini College also offers institutional scholarships and grants to full-time freshmen applicants who have applied and been accepted to Cabrini College, and who meet specific criteria.

>> **HONORS SCHOLARSHIP** – Recognizes students who are candidates for the freshmen class with a minimum 1030 SAT (critical reading and math) or higher, or 22 ACT composite score or higher, with a minimum 3.5 GPA in academic courses. Candidates must also maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 at Cabrini, and must be enrolled in the Honors Program. The Honors Scholarship is awarded in addition to other academic scholarships.

>> **CATHOLIC HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP** – Applicants must successfully graduate from a Catholic high school.

>> **CABRINI COLLEGE OUT-OF-STATE GRANT** – Students starting at Cabrini in Fall 2012 and after are eligible for an out-of-state grant. Applicants must be non-Pennsylvania residents and must live on campus.

## Needs-Based Grants

>> **CABRINI GRANT** – This grant is determined by the Financial Aid Office based on a combination of financial need as demonstrated on the FAFSA and the availability of funds. It also may be used for students with documented special circumstances.

*Financial aid awards are contingent upon receipt and verification of funds by Cabrini College. The College reserves the right to review, adjust, or cancel awards at any time because of changes in a student's, or a student's family's financial situation, academic status, housing status, or student's code of conduct violations.*

*Scholarships and grants may be based on academic merit, financial need, or both; and are exclusively applied to tuition and fees. These awards are considered "gift aid" and do not need to be repaid by the student.*
