Entrance Requirements

Our Integrated Preschool is a tuition program for children between the ages of 3 and 5 who are residents of Manasquan.

In order to register, a birth certificate and three proofs of residency must be included in the district application packet.

All preschoolers MUST comply with mandated immunization and dental regulations, and complete the required physical evaluation forms documenting health history. All preschoolers must be toilet-trained.

Enrollment is open to a limited number of preschool students without special needs, who are selected via a lottery process.

The lottery drawing for the 2017 – 2018 school year will be held on May 15 at 9:00 a.m. in the Manasquan Elementary School Media Center if the number of applications exceed available spaces. Parents will receive written notification of acceptance no later than June 1, 2017. If offered placement, confirmation of attendance is required by June 30, 2017.

An Integrated Preschool is a language-based, developmental program designed to bring preschoolers, with and without special needs, together in an integrated learning and social environment. Our program offers a typical preschool experience with the distinct advantage of a thematic curriculum blended with a modified Creative Curriculum that targets each child's specific learning style and diverse learning needs.

The most important goal of early childhood education is to help children become enthusiastic and inquisitive learners. This means encouraging children to be active and creative explorers, while learning to become independent and self-confident.

Children also need to become problem-solvers and critical thinkers.

Children learn at their own pace and in a variety of ways. Knowing this, our program is designed to meet the needs of all children by providing differentiated instruction in a caring and nurturing learning environment.

In an integrated preschool setting, high value is placed on individuality and compassion. The skills a child learns in these early stages of development provide the foundation for all other skills learned throughout life. In our Integrated Preschool Program, children develop an appreciation that everyone has unique and beautiful characteristics. When children are part of an inclusive setting, everyone benefits by gaining an understanding and appreciation of the many differences among all people – a lesson of a life time.

Afternoon (PM) Session

11:15 a.m. – 2:50 p.m.

4-5 year olds (Birthdates between October 1, 2012 – September 30, 2013)

Both sessions are held five days per week, Monday – Friday.
