# Manasquan Board of Education and Manasquan Administrator's Association Negotiations

## Memorandum of Agreement - 7/6/16

#### 1. Article I - Recognition

 Add - 12. Supervisor of Athletics and Co-Curricular Activities, Supervisor of Instruction, and Manager of Educational Facilities. Delete Supervisor of Buildings and Grounds.

#### 2. Article X - Promotions

- · Change 30 days to 15 days
- Change 15 days to 5 days

#### 3. Article XI - Salaries

- Increase each individual base salary by 2.5 % for each year of the contract
- Effective, July 1, 2016, the current Assistant Principal in the Elementary School shall change from an 11 month employee to a
  12 month employee. As compensation for the additional month the Assistant Principal shall receive \$7,000. The calculation
  shall be as follows: 15/16 salary + 2.5% increase + \$7,000 = final 16/17 salary prior to distribution of \$29,000.
- Add \$29,000 in salary funds over 3 years as requested by the MAA. The distribution of funds to individual MAA members
  must be mutually agreed upon by both the Board of Education and the MAA.
- Salaries will be retroactive to July 1, 2016.

### 4. Article XII - Insurance and Fringe Benefits

### Contribution toward health benefits under Chapter 78:

Administrator health insurance contributions shall be at Tier 4, pursuant to the table and terms set forth in Chapter 78.

#### Waiving of Medical Benefit Package (Health, Dental and RX):

If an administrator wishes to waive his or her medical benefit package, in exchange for waiving coverage, he/she shall be reimbursed in the amount of the lesser of \$5,000 or 25% of the premium saved. The reimbursement may be pro-rated for partial periods of the school year. The agreement to reduce the amount awarded for waiver of medical coverage will sunset at the end of this contract and will revert to \$7,500 for family coverage, \$5,600 for husband and wife, \$4,000 for parent and child, and \$2,500 for single, or the waiver amount provided to the majority of the certificated staff members at the time of the sunset, whichever is less.

#### Medical and Dental Coverage:

Medical Coverage Changes:

- NJ Direct Access Plan Design 7 change the current office co-pay for the PCP/Specialist from \$10 to \$15
- This revised plan will be known as NJ Direct Access Plan Design 8
- Any change in health benefits coverage will result in benefits that are substantially equivalent to the Direct Access Plan Design 8 plan

## Dental Coverage Changes:

- Increase the annual deductible from \$25 to \$50
- Increase the calendar year maximum from \$1,000 to \$1,500

### 5. Article XIII - Terminal Leave Pay

 Leave language as is, except delete the words "Grandfathered administrators having at least twelve (12) years of service shall be automatically eligible"
