SECOND ADDENDUM TO EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT Between MANASQUAN BOARD OF EDUCATION And DR. FRANK KASYAN

WHEREAS, the Manasquan Board of Education with offices located at 169 Board Street, Manasquan, New Jersey 08736 (hereinafter referred to as the "Board"), and Dr. Frank Kasyan (hereinafter referred to as the "Superintendent"), wish to amend the current employment contract which terms commenced on June 1, 2017, and expire on June 30, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Board and the Superintendent agreed to an Addendum to the written Employment Contract to extend the contract for a period of one additional year and address at the time the possible statutory modifications to salary caps, which were reflected in the addendum approved by the Board on May 14, 2019 and;

WHEREAS, the Board and the Superintendent agree to a Second Addendum to further amend the employment contract to clarify the base salary as a result of the repealing of the Superintendent salary cap, in accordance with the addendum language of May 14, 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board and the Superintendent, for the considerations stated herein, agree as follows:

1. TERM OF CONTRACT.

The Board, in consideration of the promises of the Superintendent herein contained, maintain the extension of the term of the Employment Contract to expire on June 30, 2022. Both parties acknowledge that the Monmouth County Executive County Superintendent, in accordance with applicable laws and regulations, has previously approved the contract extension.

2. PARAGRAPH 4. COMPENSATION AND OTHER PERQUISITES.

This paragraph shall be further amended to include the following:

In light of the repeal of the maximum salary statutory limits, the parties agree that salary under Paragraph 4A of the Employment Contract shall be increased to \$212,818 in the 2019-20 school year retroactively to July 19, 2019, and the annual base salary each year during the term of this agreement and shall be increased by an additional two percent (2.0%) each subsequent year of this agreement.

3. All other terms set forth in the Employment Agreement for the term June 1, 2017 through June 30, 2021, and dated May 24, 2017, shall be and remain in full force and effect for the duration of this new contract term.
