RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION OF SCHOOL FACILITIES PROJECT APPLICATIONS FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO THE MANASQUAN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL AND THE MANASQUAN HIGH SCHOOL AND SELECTION OF DEBT SERVICE AID IN SUPPORT OF SUCH PROJECTS

Whereas, the Board of Education of the Borough of Manasquan in the County of Monmouth, New Jersey anticipates conducting a special election on September 29, 2015 for the purpose of asking the voters of the School District to finance various improvements to the Manasquan Elementary School and the Manasquan High School (collectively, the "Projects"; and

Whereas, the Board of Education wants to authorize the Superintendent of Schools, Business Administrator, Garrison Architects, and other appropriate representatives (the "Board

Representatives") of the School District to submit school facilities project applications for the Projects to the New Jersey Department of Education's Office of School Facilities; and

Whereas, the Board of Education also wants to select debt service aid as the form of state financial assistance to subsidize a portion of the Projects;

NOW THEREFOR BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANASQUAN IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The educational plans and the schematic plans for the Projects are hereby approved.

Section 2. The Board Representatives are hereby authorized to submit the educational plans and the schematic plans for the Projects, along with the appropriate school facilities project applications, to the New Jersey Department of Education, Office of School Facilities for approval and to make application to the Commissioner of Education for approval of the educational plans, the schematic plans and the Projects and, if necessary, any required amendment to the long-range facilities plan, in accordance with the requirements of the Act and N.J.A.C. 6A:26-3.2.

Section 3. The Board of Education hereby elects to receive debt service aid as facilities aid pursuant to Section 9 of the *Educational Facilities Construction and Financing Act* (the "Act") to support financially a portion of the Projects.

Section 4. The Board Representatives are also authorized and directed, if necessary, to submit the schematic plans and any other required information to the Manasquan Borough Planning Board for review and comment.

Section 5. The Board representatives are hereby authorized to take all steps necessary to implement this resolution.

CONTRACT FOR THE PROVISION FOR BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL CHILD CARE PROGRAM

This Agreement, made as of this <u>1st</u> day of <u>September</u>, <u>2015</u> by and between:

THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF <u>Manasquan</u>, with offices located at 169 Broad Street, Manasquan, NJ 08736 ("District"),

and

MONMOUTH-OCEAN EDUCATIONAL SERVICES COMMISSION, with offices at 900 Hope Road, Tinton Falls, New Jersey 07712 ("MOESC").

RECITALS:

- A. MOESC offers a before and after school program for children in grades Preschool to 5th Grade ("Program"), which may be expanded upon the District's request to include Grades 6, 7 and 8.
- B. Because the District benefits from offering a before and after school program within its facilities for the convenience of its registered students and parents, the District has requested that the Program be offered for students who are registered in the District at a reasonable tuition cost for District parents.
- C. MOESC currently is contracting with KU Champions LLC ("Contractor"), with offices at 650 NE Holladay Street, Portland, OR 97232, Telephone No. 800-633-1488, Attention: Mr. Mike Alicea, malicea@klcorp.com, to provide the Program, thereby requiring that the Program provide a supervised and informal environment together with opportunities for educational enhancement, homework assistance,

additional instruction, indoor/outdoor recreational activities, arts & crafts, games, etc., as more fully described on the attached Exhibit "A".

D. The parties wish to memorialize their agreement for the Program with this Contract.

Therefore, in consideration of the mutual covenants herein contained and attached, and incorporating the Recitals hereafter in their entirety, the District and MOESC agree as follows:

- 1. Through a contractor of MOESC's selection, MOESC shall provide the Program during the dates specified herein at District facilit(ies), which facilit(ies) shall be designated as hereafter described.
 - 2. This Contract shall operate from September 1, 2015 to August 31, 2017.
- 3. The Program shall be minimally offered on the days when school is open as described in the District's calendar or as otherwise established by the District and Contractor (and copied to MOESC), and which may also include half days, holidays, shortened hours based on weather closings and/or other breaks in the school schedule as may be requested by the District in writing to Contractor with a copy to MOESC.
 - 4. MOESC shall provide the following through its contractor:
- a. . . . the Program staff who have completed criminal background checks and who shall be present at the Program in a number which is necessary or which as may be otherwise legally required to properly supervise the children attending the Program;

- b. ... Program activities which are anticipated to minimally include school/community sponsored activities, recreational activities, leisure time and educational and socialization opportunities;
 - c. ... Program supplies;
- d. . . . communication devices to enable the Program staff to contact parents, emergency personnel, the District and the MOESC contractor;
- e. . . . administration of the Program, *i.e.*, registration, billing, communications with parents, attendance tracking and assistance with the District's advertising of the Program to the District community;
 - f. ... opportunities for parental input about the Program;
- g. . . . information and training to enable the staff to utilize District security and emergency procedures.
- h. ... liability insurance in the event of damage to person or property in the single limit amount of \$1,000,000.00;
- i. . . . homework assistance and educational offerings to the children attending the Program, as may be directed by the District and the parent(s)/guardian(s);
- j. . . . an emergency procedure plan to coincide with the District's emergency procedures; and
- k. . . . the municipal police with information about the Program, including its times and locations.
 - 6. The District shall provide the following:

- a. ... a minimum of 15 full time equivalent children for attendance at the Program for five days per week;
- b. . . . secure, safe and climate controlled school building facilities which are appropriate for the Program;
 - c. ... janitorial services;
 - d. ... advertising of the Program to its community;
 - e. ... assistance with recruitment of Program staff;
- f. . . . assistance with the Program operation where requested by MOESC or its contractor;
- g. . . . provision of the District's approved school calendar to Contractor and copied to MOESC by April 30 of each calendar year before the start of the school year and any calendar revision no less than thirty (30) days prior to the institution of the calendar revision;
 - h. ... a security system for the facilities where the Program is located;
- i. . . . liability insurance covering the District's operations and facility where the Program is located in the District in a minimum amount of \$1,000,000.00;
- j. . . . contact information for the Program parents via the District's established procedures in the event of an emergency or a Program schedule change;
- k. . . . the current information about the educational, emotional, behavioral and/or medical/special needs as may be advisable and relevant for each District student who is enrolled in the Program. (Information shall be updated by the District as needed throughout the Program's operation with the intent being to

sufficiently inform the Program staff about the individual needs of each child attending the Program.);

- 1. . . . assistance with the Program's ability to implement the District emergency procedures;
- m. ... in-District transportation to or from the Program where and when necessary as determined by the District personnel for District students with the cost of transportation, if any, to be borne by the District; and
- n. . . . records and copies of all communications between the Contractor and the District to MOESC.
 - 7. The Program is currently described on Exhibit "A".
- a. Activities: Program activities will be based upon the needs and abilities of the children attending the Program, the available physical facilities and the Program staff qualifications. Student-oriented activities, among others, may include: physical activities, supervised free play, shared reading and/or the completion of homework assignments, with the help of a qualified educator, library work, arts and crafts and/or theatre projects, construction projects related to science or nature, learning about healthy foods and the opportunity, as permitted and provided for in each respective site, to cook, create and eat the final project (s), all supervised by professionally-trained adult(s).
- b. Dietary Needs: Time will be allowed for eating snack foods as part of the Program's daily schedule. (Parents may send snack foods with their children for

consumption during the Program and shall provide for any special dietary health needs of their child.)

- c. Eligibility: The Program shall be available to children who are enrolled in the District and who are in the grades from Preschool to 8th grades as determined by each District.
- d. Tuition Payments: The parent/guardian shall be financially responsible for tuition payments to the MOESC contractor in accordance with the MOESC contractor's tuition payment procedures. In the event tuition payments are not timely made, the Program services may be terminated for the affected student(s).
- e. Tuition to be Charged to Parent(s) Based on Enrollment Selections:

 Tuition shall be charged to parents based on their enrollment selection. Discounts may
 be available for longer periods of enrollment and for siblings. Otherwise, tuition for daily
 enrollment shall be based upon the number of days selected for each enrolled child.
- f. Hours and Days of Operation: The Program's standard, daily operation shall follow the District's school calendar or as otherwise established by the District and the Contractor.
- (1) Monthly/Weekly Enrollment: The Program will operate during weekdays when the District's schools are open and the District's facilities are available for the Program's use. The morning and afternoon hours of Program operation shall start as established and the afternoon hours of operation shall be determined and mutually agreed upon the District and the Contractor.

- (2) Daily Enrollment: District students may be enrolled for in the Program by the parent for between one and five days per week.
- (3) Holiday enrollment: Where permitted by the District, District students may be enrolled for days when school is closed for a holiday, if the District and the Contractor mutually agree that the Program will operate on the holiday.
- (4) Drop-in Care Available: "As needed" or "drop-in" care slots may be available at each site, as permitted by the Contractor.
- (5) One-Session and Recess Day Availability: Select one-session and school recess days, as permitted by the District and agreed to by the Contractor, may be available for parents.

(6) Delayed Opening and Early Closing:

- (a) Delayed District Opening: If the District schedules a delayed opening, the Program will open at a time agreed upon between the District and the Contractor.
- (b) Early Closing of School: If schools are closed early, the Program may be open for a maximum of an additional number of hours after the closing of school, as mutually determined and agreed upon by the District and the Contractor.
- g. Registration: Parents shall complete a registration packet and pay the registration fee to the Contractor.
- h. Registration Information to the District: Upon request, Contractor shall supply to the District a list of all District students who are registered in the Program.

- i. Facility: The Program site shall be operated in a District's school building appropriate for the Program, which shall be mutually selected by MOESC (or its contractor) and a representative from the District's Office of the Superintendent and shall be licensable. The facilities to be selected shall minimally allow for a stimulating, safe and secure environment and shall include but not be limited to, gymnasium(s), cafeteria(s), classroom(s), bathrooms, appropriate outdoor recreational facilities, and a secure space to house Program supplies.
- j. Staff: The Program staff shall be employed by MOESC's contractor. Staff shall consist of on-site, adult care persons who have cleared background checks. All positions shall be advertised to meet the requirements of an equal opportunity employer. The training of Program staff shall be the responsibility of MOESC's contractor. The child/adult staff ratio shall not exceed 15:1.
- k. Transportation: Transportation from and to the Program is the responsibility of the parent/guardian or District, as applicable and shall not be the responsibility of MOESC or its Contractor.
- l. Release of Children from Program: The children attending the Program shall only be released from the Program to a parent, a guardian or an adult identified by the parent or guardian in writing, who is at least 18 years of age and who has been authorized in writing by the parent or guardian. The parent, guardian or other adult shall be pre-authorized in writing, shall provide identification satisfactory to the Program staff and shall follow all procedures as may be required by the Program for the child's release. For any child not picked up within one hour of the Program's close and

persons authorized to pick up the child cannot be reached, the Site Director will determine whether Child Protective Services or the appropriate authorities should be contacted based on state licensing regulations. If appropriate authorities are contacted, a note in a sealed envelope will be posted on the door with specific information regarding the child's whereabouts, including the name and phone number of the agency or person to contact.

- 8. The District may request the replacement of a Program staff member, provided it first provides a five (5) school day written notice to Contractor with a copy to MOESC, and that such notice contains an explanation for the request.
- 9. In the event that this Agreement is terminated by the District prior to the expiration of its two year term, the District shall not contract with the Contractor during the term of this Agreement and for twenty-four (24) months following the termination of this Agreement unless the District pays MOESC \$2,000.00 per each District's Program location as an introduction and finder's fee. (This amount was established by determining the mean, gross income received by MOESC for each location based on data from May 2014.
- 10. Either MOESC or the District may cancel this Agreement, in whole or in part, upon six (6) months' advance written notice unless enrollment drops below the minimum of 15 students at a Program location, in which case, MOESC may terminate this Agreement upon fourteen (14) days' advance written notice.

- 11. MOESC reserves the right to change to a different contractor from the present Contractor and to immaterially modify the Program as described herein and on Exhibit "A".
- 12. Any notice given in connection with this Agreement shall be given in writing and shall be delivered by a method documenting delivery, such as by certified mail, return receipt requested or by overnight delivery service, to the Superintendent of the party at the office address described above.
- 13. In the event any claims or disputes arise involving services provided under this Agreement, the remedy shall be limited to the replacement of the disputed services.
- 14. In the event any claims or disputes arise that involve non-parties to this Agreement and which are related to the Program services provided by MOESC or its contractor pursuant to this Agreement, the District shall promptly (1) notify MOESC when it becomes aware of any such claim or dispute; (2) allow thirty (30) days for MOESC (and/or its contractor) to resolve the claim/dispute; and (3) cooperate with MOESC in its attempt to resolve any such third party claims or disputes, including, but not limited to, attending, participating and joining in meetings, conferences, hearings and dispute resolution proceedings.
- 15. The Program shall not deny admission to, terminate enrollment of, or otherwise discriminate against any child for any proscribed reason including a child's disability and shall provide accommodations for children who require special services during their attendance at the Program unless the accommodation imposes an undue hardship on the Program. MOESC or the Contractor reserves the right to terminate the

Program for any child where the child's safety is reasonably believed by MOESC or the Contractor to be at risk.

- 16. Any controversy or claim arising out of or relating to this Agreement or its breach, which is unable to be resolved by the parties after written notice and a thirty (30) calendar day opportunity to correct, shall be confidentially resolved by non-binding mediation. If the controversy is not resolved by mediation, then the controversy or claim shall be brought before the Executive County Superintendent of Monmouth County or his/her designee who shall arbitrate any such dispute.
- 17. Each party will indemnify, defend and hold harmless the other party, including its agents, servants and employees, from any and all suits, claims, damages, liabilities, attorney's fees, costs, for any and all injuries to persons or property damage arising from any acts or omissions by its agents, servants, contractors and/or employees. This covenant shall include the provision of a defense at all stages of the judicial, administrative or mediation/arbitration process.
- 18. This Agreement contains the entire agreement of the parties and shall not be modified except by the written agreement of the parties. No representations, inducements, promises or agreements, oral or otherwise, including descriptive brochures or websites, which are not embodied within this Agreement, shall not constitute a term or condition of this Agreement and shall not be of any force or effect.
- 19. This Agreement supersedes any prior contracts, negotiations, discussion or communications between the MOESC and the District regarding before and after school programs.

20. Neither party may sell, assign, transfer nor otherwise dispose of its obligations, as set forth herein, without the other party's prior written consent.

To further reinforce 21st Century Learning and the Common Core Standards and also to support STEM, Champions incorporates science—including building and construction, problem-solving, scientific concepts, and more—into every unit of our curriculum. Outside of our curriculum, our teachers encourage experimentation and invention, which can lead to even further scientific achievement. We also incorporated technology skills into our programs, as appropriate, and can also offer a complete, out-of-the-box digital learning solution customized by age group and customizable to each student's specific learning needs.

QUALITY AND TRAINING CYCLE TO CONTINUOUSLY IMPROVE THE PROGRAM

Through rigorous, ongoing quality and training processes centered on in-depth program assessment, Champions regularly evaluates the program environment, teacher effectiveness (using a teacher rubric based on the work of Charlotte Danielson), and client and customer satisfaction (through parent, school/district, and staff engagement surveys). Solid data derived from this assessment



process informs our targeted staff training, allowing us to constantly drive high-quality programming and increase program satisfaction through meaningful enhancements.

INVESTMENT IN A PLANNED LEARNING ENVIRONMENT

Champions' expertise lies in creating a warm, caring learning environment out of a variety of spaces. We invest approximately \$12,000-\$15,000 in each site we open, ensuring our curriculum, equipment, and materials support 21st Century Learning's Planned Learning Environment criteria. The environment, stocked with compelling age-appropriate materials, is conducive to exploration and discovery through activity choices. All program materials are replenished and refurbished as needed.

AGE-SPECIFIC CURRICULUM

Champions' curriculum is differentiated to address varying age groups and developmental levels. Labeled curriculum manuals help staff provide age-appropriate activities. Children can engage in many of our activities at varied levels of complexity. For example, a first-grade child could be challenged by the fundamentals of an activity while a fourth-grader can add components to enhance the activity's degree of complexity. In addition, Champions' participants enjoy special, quiet areas well-stocked with high-quality, age-appropriate children's literature. For preschool-age children, our classrooms are separated by National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC) recommended age groups and adhere to all group size and teacher-to-child ratio licensing requirements.

COMMUNITIES OF SATISFIED PARENTS

Parents—who are, in some regards, our most important analysts—continually say great things about our programs. Through our recent parent survey process, the vast majority of our parents indicated Champions gives them peace of mind regarding their children before and after school. Champions' parents also demonstrated a very high willingness to recommend and remain with the program and were typically "very pleased" with the quality of Champion staff. Further, the vast majority of parents agree that Champions provides a fun learning environment and are satisfied with the level and quality of homework help their children receive; our surveys also clearly demonstrate that very little is more important to our parents than a quality homework program. Satisfaction with Champions' homework component strongly correlates with overall program satisfaction.



PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

CHAMPIONS CURRICULUM

Champions' core curriculum is segmented into exciting, mind-expanding, hands-on Activity Areas, which support 21st Century Learning and skills, as well as Common Core and STEM, through these Activity Areas:

- Community Building Session Meeting to plan and reflect on learning goals
- Homework Emphasis Homework, brain teasers, puzzles, and mind-bending games
- Creative Arts— Self-expression through music, dance, drawing, painting, and more
- Science— Learning about the world around us, our universe, and scientific exploration
- Physical Activity—Individual or group activities and/or sports to build understanding of daily activity as part of a healthy lifestyle
- Technology—Technology options created specifically for before and after school time
- Snack A healthy, nutritious snack designed to "recharge" children

COMMON CORE STANDARDS

Champions reinforces 21st Century Learning, STEM and the Common Core Standards throughout our environment and curriculum evidenced in our Activity Planning Resource Guides (APRs) as well as our Read*Write*Now! literacy enhancement program. Some examples of specific Common Core standard learning activities used to develop Champions' weekly lesson plans include:

- · Activities designed to build cognitive, social-emotional, and physical skills
- Programming developed to support college- and career-ready students in reading, writing, speaking, listening, and language including: demonstrating independence, responding to various demands of audience, comprehending and critiquing, and understanding other perspectives
- Engaging activities that build comprehension, fluency, and vocabulary skills in a fun way
- · Literacy activities including discussion, journal prompts, and enhancing comprehension
- Constant assessment of learner understanding and engagement coupled with displaying evidence of learning to reflect student efforts

The Champions Before and After School Program supports the Common Core Standards' Habits of Mind knowledge, skills and dispositions, including:

- Making sense of problems and persevering to solve them
- Critical thinking skills
- Attending to precision
- · Demonstrating independent thinking
- Using technology



Understanding other cultures and perspectives

In an environment encouraging of children's choice, in which students regularly supply input regarding program activities and select from a variety of activity areas each day, Champions constantly reinforces the above skills. Activities also emphasize the value of diversity and community outreach, helping children reach across cultural divides and appreciate the power of diversity.

TEACHER RESOURCE MANUAL

Champions' proprietary curriculum supports all of our instructors in program activity planning while also ensuring environments are comprised of abundant learning opportunities and fun! The proprietary resource manuals have been developed by educators to provide a variety of themebased activities—incorporating student input and instructor creativity—to facilitate weekly planning efforts. Other features include:

- Labeled sections to help staff differentiate content and provide developmentally appropriate activities for children of different ages
- Fun, hands-on and minds-on activities that target development of math, language arts, science, social studies, motor, and life skills

Champions' program will fully support MOESC member school districts in the goal of integrating and assessing 21st Century Learning and skills. KU's Education Team designed our curriculum to support 21st Century Learning and skills in multiple ways:

PLANNED LEARNING ENVIRONMENT

As an invested and committed partner, Champions works with each school to successfully transform a variety of spaces into learning environments with clearly defined activity areas. The program environment is designed with developmentally appropriate equipment and materials that facilitate fun and learning in a variety of content areas and for mixed-age groups.

OPPORTUNITIES FOR LEARNING AND INNOVATION SKILL DEVELOPMENT

Staff engage students in guided discovery and work with students to plan fun activities with specific learning objectives. Instruction is differentiated based on each student's interests, skills, and needs.

DEVELOPMENT OF LIFE AND CAREER SKILLS

Individual lessons often include questions to facilitate higher-level thinking, and variations and extensions help staff differentiate activities based on student age and interest. Character development and community projects help children understand how they can serve and benefit the community. Hands-on lessons and activities focus on or build fundamental life skills, including understanding how money works in society; oral communication skills; and knowing how to quickly find answers to questions. These skills are the building blocks that future job seekers will need for interviewing and maintaining employment.



TECHNOLOGY SKILLS

To enhance our ability to address STEM, Champions can offer a digital learning solution, when appropriate, which is designed specifically for out-of-school time use. Also, Champions has seen great success when we partner with schools to utilize computer labs while reinforcing the environment with Champions curriculum.

DEVELOPMENT OF THE WHOLE CHILD

Opportunities in the following key areas are integrated throughout the curriculum and focus on the development of the whole child:

- Literacy, which includes reading and vocabulary-building projects; journaling and writing; and the Champions Book Club
- Wellness, which teaches children the value of a healthy lifestyle and good nutrition while incorporating physical exercise
- Character Development involves children in community activities, encourages family
 participation, and teaches healthy, effective conflict-resolution techniques—while reinforcing
 school behavioral goals.

Activity Choices

Language Arts —Book clubs; reading aloud; a comfy, well-stocked reading area; journaling; writing; and word puzzles and games help children refine their literacy skills.

SUPPORT FOR HOMEWORK

Recognizing the importance of homework completion to student achievement and to families, Champions incorporates homework assistance as a key component in its programming. The Champions team supports and assists children in completing their homework and eliminates the hassles of at-home homework—increasing quality family time. Some important Homework Support Resources our programs utilize are the following:

- Homework Best Practices Standards and procedures staff use as a guide when implementing the homework component
- Student Homework Survey A survey children complete to express their individual needs for completing homework
- Homework Contracts A contract parents and children use annually in which children agree to complete their homework in the Champions program
- Good Reader Strategies Strategies shared with children for use during reading and when decoding words
- Math At-A-Glance Teacher Resource Sheet Tips and strategies for staff when assisting children
 with math homework
- Math At-A-Glance Student Resource Sheet Tips and strategies for children to use when completing math homework and solving computation problems
- Homework Zone Signs Signs that communicate the need for a quiet environment conducive to homework completion

Champions' policy is to hire teachers with the skills and experience to provide quality homework help; we also train our staff on the Common Core Standards and 21st Century Learning and how to support these learning frameworks.



PROGRAM ENVIRONMENT AND EQUIPMENT

Champions' expertise lies in creating warm, caring learning environments in a variety of spaces. As previously mentioned, we invest a *transformational* amount of time and resources into each site we open, ensuring our curriculum, equipment, and materials support 21st Century Learning's Planned Learning Environment criteria. Moveable rolling cabinets store Champions' equipment and materials, allowing flexibility to adapt to a variety of program spaces. For optimal program operation, we do request some storage space for our materials. A list of program materials and equipment is available upon request. Examples of items and important materials Champions uses to enhance the student experience include:

- Comfortable and colorful rugs
- Soft seating for cozy reading
- High-quality portable storage units
- Abundant books and reading materials
- Age-appropriate consumable products for creative exploration

PARENT COMMUNICATION

Champions believes building close relationships with our parents, school administrators, and teachers is critical to program success. The Champions' communication philosophy incorporates a variety of interaction channels that help our parents stay connected to teachers and the fun learning experiences their child has each day:



Open Door Policy: Champions' policy is to encourage parents to visit unannounced at any time. We welcome parents' presence at all times and are extremely interested in feedback. At some sites, we hold parent focus groups to help us gather candid feedback in a relaxed setting.

Orientation: To establish appropriate parent expectations, we orient parents to policies and procedures and to Champions' philosophy. Parents receive Champions' Family Handbook along with

a current tuition schedule and information required for processing their child's enrollment.



Verbal Communication: Champions encourages the casual daily exchange between parents and staff when the child is picked up. This immediate feedback helps parents and site staff work together for the good of the child. Parents may request a conference at any time.

Written Communication: Champions provides newsletters to parents. In some of our programs, children participate in publishing

the newsletter, which announces the next month's calendar, menus, and special events; and provides information specific to each program.

Parent Engagement Surveys: In partnership with Gallup, a leading performance management company, we also administer Parent Engagement Surveys twice per year. These surveys help us measure our staff's ability to involve parents in program events and activities and generate overall parent enthusiasm. We also share these results with the school, parents and children.

Addressing Parent Concerns: Information is provided to parents regarding the process for addressing their concerns. The first step is to work with the parent to make sure he or she is satisfied with our services. Specifically, any concerns regarding program operation should be directed to each school's site director (a Champions' employee). The site director will inform the area manager of any major concerns the site director cannot handle onsite. The area manager will orally respond to all concerns. When necessary, the regional manager (to whom the area manager directly reports) will become aware of the concern and address it appropriately.



COMMUNICATION WITH SCHOOL AND DISTRICT ADMINISTRATORS

Our dedicated site director at each school works closely with school boards, principals, and other administrative personnel to regularly update all stakeholders. Our client communication emphasis is evident in a variety of areas:

- We distribute monthly program newsletters and flyers to our school and district partners, and our staff remind parents about upcoming meetings.
- We conduct meetings with each principal at the principal's desired frequency and semi-annual meetings with district personnel.
- We present program updates at school board meetings.
- Principal surveys are conducted to gauge program satisfaction levels.
- We coordinate with classroom teachers to reinforce classroom concepts in the before and after school environment.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT AND SUPPORT

Champions is an exemplary supporter and facilitator of school and district initiatives through fundraising, volunteerism, contributions, and many other avenues. Some of the activities and initiatives we spearhead for our New Jersey school partners include:

- Champions programs can remain open during school breaks and over the summer to support busy, working families.
- Area managers support school meetings during which administrators, parents, and Champions can discuss topics and concerns related to each school and the community.
- Champions supports Cancer Awareness Month and Heart Disease Month by handing out informational flyers to families and teaching children about lifestyle changes that can reduce the risk of acquiring these diseases.
- Champions is a strong Wave of Hope supporter. In one district, our staff can wear jeans on Friday if they contribute to Wave of Hope. We also purchase Wave of Hope attire, and as an organization, have contributed directly to this great cause.
- During Hurricane Sandy, we participated in fundraisers and gathered essential supplies for the victims; donations were made to the local fire station.
- We are pleased to provide multi-child discounts on tuition and on registration.
- We waive one week of tuition for families due to death of parents.
- We welcome and facilitate third-party assistance for families in all of our New Jersey programs.

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT AND PROGRAM SUPPORT

As an education company, staff training and professional development is a key focus area. In 2013 alone, KU invested over \$20.7 million in training and development. On average, staff receive at least 40 hours of training annually, although we do not limit the amount of training our teachers can



obtain. We continuously evaluate and invest in our teachers. Below is a comprehensive breakdown of staff education and professional development opportunities provided upon hire and throughout staff tenure to ensure our teachers exceed industry standards.

SAFETY

Nothing is more important to champions than keeping children safe. Champions' staff perform child counts every 30 minutes to ensure each child's safety and presence. If the group is split, staff prepare a list including the names and number of children for whom they are responsible. Staff will mark off and add to their lists when children leave and join their groups. All enrolled children are supervised and accounted for at all times. Supervision is covered in our first orientation and training segment. Staff members learn that the most critical aspect of supervision is never leaving children unattended or unsupervised for any reason.

An important aspect of Champions' safety and security policy is our close coordination and communication with parents and guardians and the school and district. We ensure our procedures are fully aligned with each school's policies and communicate those procedures to parents upon enrollment. We perform all emergency drills according to each school's schedule and attend staff safety meetings to stay abreast of policy changes. Our goal is to reinforce school practices. Twice per year, we refresh parents on our safety plan. KU's fully customizable emergency plan is available upon request. We are more than happy to work with MOESC or the individual school districts to refine and customize the safety procedures at each site.

ADDITIONAL WAYS WE ENSURE CHILDREN'S SAFETY

Champions' staff develop solid relationships with parents and guardians of children enrolled in the program. They are immediately on their guard if an individual they do not know appears at the site. Parents sign in and out in our computer-based system. Parents must indicate on the enrollment form all individuals allowed to sign their child in or out. We also check photo IDs to verify identification. If children leave our program and return, they must be re-signed in and out by an authorized adult. Our program staff will not release any child to an individual who has not been fully authorized by the child's parents.

PROGRAM LICENSING

Participating in the state licensing and ongoing renewal process ensures regular third-party evaluation of our programs' health and safety, and focuses on the environment and staff. Our Champions Licensing Compliance Officer has 25 years of child care licensing expertise, and keeps site staff on pace with specific state regulations that ensure a safe environment, qualified staff, and ongoing training.
