 - > \$8,147,000 for renovations and additions to High School






MANASQUAN PUBLIC SCHOOLS OVERALL PROGRAM SCHEDULE

Elementary School Projects

Elementary School HVAC Controls:

- Trane contract (including Phase I and Phase II Investigations) for \$407,770
- Training with District Personnel has been completed
- Kappa to prepare a proposal (as alternative to Trane's proposal) to modify hot water hydronic piping in "A" wing, replace existing HHW circulating pumps and add variablefrequency drives (VFD's). Piping mods and new pumps will increase flow; VFD's will improve system efficiency

Elementary School Projects

Elementary School Site Improvements:

- Contract awarded to Your Way Construction for \$651,775 (includes Alt #2 for rubberized playground surface)
- Playground equipment has been delivered to site (for installation by Your Way)
- Your Way has provided ~ 95% of submittals; color selections have been made by District
- Storm drainage piping and structures and retaining wall block have been delivered to site
- Utility markouts and survey work for parking lot and field are complete
- Site demo and clearing scheduled to begin 7/23/18

Elementary School Projects

Elementary School Media Center Renovations:

- New Road is coordinating individual contracts for ceiling demo, ceiling installation, electrical, flooring (carpet and VCT), painting
- Existing furnishings have been removed by District
- Ceiling demo complete; new grid installation underway (~20% complete)
- Electrical demo underway (~65% complete)
- Furniture delivery scheduled for late August
- Lighting fixtures scheduled to arrive in two weeks

HS Construction Projects

Alternative Education Building Renovations

- \$195,000 contract with Shorelands Construction
- Borough issued construction permit 7/11/18
- Interior framing is complete
- Exterior sheathing complete; vinyl siding to start this week
- HVAC equipment has been installed; electrical and ductwork to follow



HS Construction Projects

HS Renovations and Additions:

- Contract awarded to Kappa Construction Corp for \$6,936,500.00
- CMU block construction complete; vapor barrier has been applied to block; brick veneer construction underway; cast stone installation to begin next week
- EPDM roof has been applied to building addition
- HVAC equipment installation progressing (DSS units, CUH's and exhaust fans installed)
- Ductwork installation continuing; ground floor and first floor mains complete; second floor mains underway



HS Renovations and Additions (cont'd):

- Electrical rough-in almost complete; feeders to subpanels, receptacles, switches and lights are being run throughout first floor
- Interior door frames have been installed
- Structural Steel erection complete; stairs "A" and "B" installed
- Project currently 50.0% complete



Change Management:

- Change Orders 01 and 02 have been approved by BOE
- Current approved change orders (including CO#2) total \$9,054.14 (0.13% of original contract value)
- Project unforeseen conditions allowance balance of \$102,263


