

Lester Leming Memorial Scholarship - 2021

Administered by the Manasquan First Aid Squad

The Lester Leming Memorial Scholarship is a \$500 scholarship awarded annually since 1991 in honor of Les Leming, a long-time volunteer in the Manasquan First Aid Squad. In addition to countless hours of service as a first-aider, Mr. Leming was an advocate for the youth of the town. It is our hope that, through this scholarship, the memory of Les will continue to inspire others to serve their community.

I. APPLICANTS TO BE CONSIDERED FOR AWARD MUST:

- A. Be a resident of Manasquan or Sea Girt.
- B. Be accepted by an accredited college or university with written notification submitted to committee with application.
- C. Submit a cover letter detailing involvement in school clubs, teams, extracurricular activities, volunteer work, etc. and explaining future plans, goals, and aspirations. Special consideration will be given to candidates who have served on a volunteer first aid squad and/or to candidates planning to pursue a career in a medical or health related field.
- D. Submit a high school transcript.
- E. Submit two letters of reference as follows:
 - One letter from a guidance counselor, school advisor, principal, or teacher.
 - One letter from someone who has known the applicant for at least five years and can attest to their character. This can be an employer, church or community leader, neighbor, etc.

II. GENERAL ADMINISTRATIVE GUIDELINES

- A. Completed applications must be received no later than 5 p.m. on Friday, April 30th. Applications should either be mailed to the Manasquan First Aid Squad, 65 Broad Street, Manasquan, NJ 08736, or be placed in the mailbox on the south side of the first aid building.
- B. The scholarship winner will be notified on or about May 5th.
- C. The scholarship will be paid directly to the individual via check at the May 11th business meeting of the Manasquan First Aid Squad.
